Entries must be postmarked by August 3, 2010 or **double fees will apply. NO REFUNDS** after close of entries. **Post entries at the doubled fee will be accepted on day of show and substitutions are allowed at no extra fee if declared prior to 9:30 AM, August 17.**

Non registered goats **MUST** be ear tagged with an official scrapie tag. Registered goats must have an official scrapie tag *or* be accompanied by original registration papers matching their legible tattoos.

NYS animals must have a certificate of veterinary inspection (CVI) dated May 1, 2010 or later. Out of state animals must have an interstate CVI. Interstate CVI's are valid for 30 days. During the fair season (July 1 thru labor day), interstate CVI's can be used multiple times as long as the initial entrance to a fair in NY is within 30 days of issuance. An interstate CVI must be issued by an accredited veterinarian and countersigned by the state veterinarian in the state of origin.

Each individual animal must be identified on the CVI.

Animals and health papers will be checked prior to show time. **ALL ANIMALS MUST BE HEALTHY.** No visible signs of abscesses or other contagious diseases (pinkeye, soremouth, ringworm, foot scald, etc.) will be allowed. In case of a discrepancy, or for rules not adequately covered, the show committee decision will be final.

All entries must be on the grounds by 8:45 AM, August 17. Check-ins are allowed 8:30 AM through 9:30am on day of show. Pens will be assigned on a first come, first served basis. Initial bedding provided. No animals are allowed to run free in the aisles; dogs must be leashed.

Goats entered in meat classes must be owned or leased by exhibitor no later than July 17, 2010

Weights to be determined on site for classes 1 and 2

May add middleweight class according to entries

Class 2 - Heavyweights (40 pounds and over)

Class 3 – Market Kids owned or leased by youth

Class 29 – 0-3 months Doe kids
Class 30 – 3-6 months Doe kids
Class 31 – 6-9 months Doe kids
Class 32 – 9-12 months Doe kids
Class 33 – 0-12 months Doe kids owned or leased by youth
Class 34 – Champion & Reserve Junior Doe

Class 35– Yearling Does (never kidded)
Class 36 – Freshened Does under 2 years of age
Class 37 – Mature does – 2 yrs or older
Class 38 – Champion and Reserve Senior Doe
Class 39 – Grand and Reserve Grand Champion Doe
Class 40 – Best Doe bred by youth exhibitor – Must be named before show
Class 41 –Best of Show

Class 42 – Junior Youth Showmanship (no entry fee) youth must have owned, raised, or trained goat and must be 8 to 11 yrs. old.

Class 43 – Senior Youth Showmanship (no entry fee) youth must have owned, raised, or trained goat and must be 12 to 18 yrs. Old.

We strongly encourage youth to participate in the no-cost showmanship classes!!!

Please note: Registration is from 8:30am to 9:30am August 17, 2010 - all entries must be received and paid by 9:30am. Age and weight is as of check in at show. All goats MUST be on the grounds by 8:45am August 17, 2010, MUST be ear tagged or tattooed with official scrapie identification, and accompanied by a health certificate (See page 1 for more details on health requirements.)
